INTRODUCTION

The ***Tutoring Resource List*** has been compiled by school counselors in North Shore Schools to assist parents and students. Counselors provided the *Tutoring Application Form* to staff and community members who have provided tutoring services in the past or those who have recently contacted the schools to offer tutoring services. The chart attached represents information provided by these individuals. All applicants have been included in this listing without any omissions, screening or recommendations by staff. Accuracy of the information provided on the applications and included in the chart should be verified by the parent or student at the time of contact with the tutor and inquiry for services. Updates of the listing will be made as we receive new applications and current information from the tutors.

Neither North Shore Schools nor any school counselor receives compensation from the tutors for compiling the listing or for providing the listing to individuals seeking tutoring assistance. Current teachers for the student should not receive remuneration for tutoring services even if the services are provided beyond the school day. The ***Tutoring Resource List*** provides contact information and status for New York certifications in subjects. Fees are usually based on one hour of instruction (may vary). Actual rate and any special arrangements related to tutoring should be requested at the time of contact with the tutor.

STEPS TO OBTAINING SUCCESSFUL ACADEMIC SUPPORT

1. Confer with your child's classroom or subject area teacher to learn about student strengths and growth areas. Identify specific academic areas of concern that could be addressed by extra help. Ask about times that the teacher may be available for assistance.
2. Discuss with the teacher possible strategies that parents can do at home to provide academic support. For example, parents can help by providing a structured study period each evening as well as including specific practice and instructional reviews to help.
3. Meet with the school counselor to explore tutoring programs that may be available at the school.
4. Explore options for academic assistance in the community. Some church groups, local libraries, Boys and Girls Clubs, YMCA etc, sponsor extra help sessions independently or as part of other student activities. It never hurts to ask what is currently available.
5. Many private organizations, businesses and online services offer tutorial assistance. These companies frequently advertise in local newspapers, on TV, over the internet or through mailings to homes. Local listings are available in the phone directory and through computer searches.
6. Before you begin any tutoring relationship, whether with an individual tutor or through a company, know what you can commit of your time and finances. Get the details of when and where the tutoring will occur. Know what would happen if you and your child should decide to discontinue the tutoring service. Some companies require an educational evaluation before services can begin so understand what is involved in the process.
