# PROPOSITION 2

Permission to establish a Capital Reserve Fund for a period of 10 years that will be funded up to \$8.5 million dollars for the following projects:

- **Glen Head School:** Replacement of 1995 boilers & 1950 septic tanks; renovation to the nurse's office; air conditioning in the library & cafeteria
- **Glenwood Landing School:** Replacement of 1950 septic tanks, exterior doors & interior ceramic tiles; air conditioning in the library & auditorium
- **Sea Cliff School:** Replace windows on the second floor, exhaust fans in halls & stairways; new flooring in the 1st & 2nd floor classrooms on the east side of the building; walk-in refrigerator & freezer; air conditioning in the cafeteria
- **Middle School:** Renovate boys/girls locker rooms; air conditioning in the cafeteria
- **High School:** Replace entire cafeteria ceiling/install LED lighting; replace sidewalks in the rear of the building & around the courtyard; air conditioning in the gym
- **Central Office:** Re-pipe existing hot water heating system; excavate/waterproof perimeter of building & foundation; install new generator to power building; level floors

North Shore School District is Below  
The Allowable N.Y. State Tax Levy Limit

- The 2016-17 Budget is \$99,494,105 representing a 1.97% budget increase from last year.
- Trustees decided on a tax levy (the amount collected in local property taxes) for 2016-17 that is estimated at \$84,498,091.
- Revenues including the LIPA payments in lieu of taxes (PILOT) are estimated at \$14,996,014.
- Also on the ballot is Proposition 2 - permission to establish a Capital Reserve Fund. Please see the back of this card for more information.
